CRITERION I – CURRICULAR ASPECTS

1.1 Curriculum Planning and Implementation

1.1.1 Institution has the mechanism for well planned curriculum delivery and documentation.

Institution follows curriculum designed by Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati. The institution ensures effective curriculum delivery through a well planned academic plan. Institution prepared a planned academic calendar for academic year 2017-18 before its commencement and implement from the beginning of academic year 2017-18. The academic calendar approved by the College Council / Staff Council is provided to College time-table committee, academic committee and academic incharge monitor effective implementation of the curriculum.

Month wise activities for students are performed in a regular manner. Teachers in the department plays a vital role for conducting various activities. Taking student as a centre point, various extra curricular and co-curricular activities are performed during academic year 2017-18. For this purpose various committees and incharge or teachers are took keen interest for smooth conduct of activities. Academic diary consisting of proposed teaching plan and actual teaching plan are maintained for delivery of curriculum. Institute adopted **Class Teacher Scheme** in which every class teacher looks after each student about his academic work. Meetings of class teachers were held in regular intervals so that the curriculum should be completed within a stipulated time. Students are encouraged for participation in social activities like tree plantation, blood donation, cleanliness drive, public awareness campaigns, etc.

Apart from class room teaching, the various activities like cultural programs, sports, debates, arts competitions; Mini Bazar, Industrial Visits, etc are performed during the year 2017-18. These activities help students to acquire qualities, attitudes and social values for its overall personality development.

The faculty members are elected on Board of Studies who contribute their views and suggestions in curriculum updates and designing. Our institute adopted semester pattern given by the University to UG and PG classes. CBCS is adopted for PG Courses. Comprehensive feedback analysis mechanism by the student and teachers are adopted in the college. The college campus is covered under CCTV Cameras for the security purpose. Every department in college is well equipped with internet facility.

1.4.2 How the feedback obtained is being analyzed and utilized for overall development of the institution? (maximum 500 words)					
<p>A feedback has a significant role for functioning the institute in an efficient and speedy way. A comprehensive feedback system is adopted in the institute. A feedback from the student about Principal, teachers, college office, library and department of physical education are collected at the end of every academic year. Students put their opinions about all stakeholders in separate forms of questionnaire provided by the institute. A format of Principal has seven questions in which each question has three options to tick the answer and carry five, four and three marks respectively. A similar format of sixteen questions for teachers are framed with five options to tick and carry five, four, three, two and one marks. For college office staff, library and DPE has a separate format of five questions each are framed with four options and carry respectively five, four, three, and two marks.</p> <p>A list of five to ten regular students is collected from each class teacher of his batch. Class-wise meetings of these students are called on a particular date, time and a feedback form are filled from them. At the beginning of the next academic year these feedback forms are evaluated by the teachers of the institute by taking average scores and total scores. After analysis of feedback forms, the Principal of the institute discussed the total score secured with all stakeholders and took necessary measures for empowerment, so that it becomes beneficial for all round development of the institute.</p>

2.3.2 Student Mentoring system available in the Institution? Give details.(500 words)

Institution has a well established scheme to cater to the needs of the students. It is called as Tutor – Ward Scheme. In this scheme, a group of 20 to 30 students is allotted to a teacher who works as a guardian of the group and provides them personal, academic and psycho-social support throughout their stay of three years in the college.

The class teacher arranges a meeting (in the first week of every month) with the batch of students allotted to him/her. In this meeting, class teacher collects information on:

- Extent of course completed
- Difficulties faced by students in understanding the subject
- Availability of Library books
- Internet facility
- Difficulties in practical classes
- Infrastructure facilities

The class teacher collects data on family circumstances and academic performance of each student of the group. Monthly meeting of the students is arranged by him to know their academic and other difficulties. The class teacher also frequently visits their homes and provides them personal and psycho-social support. Irregular and weak students are identified and are counseled for their studies also the advanced learners are identified though the interaction in classrooms, score of unit test examinations and the grasping power of the students and their performance in co-curricular activities.

The novel Tutor – Ward Scheme with the same teacher for three years of UG course helps in building relations with the students, helping them in their difficulties and motivating them for better performance. In the process, the teacher becomes friend, philosopher, guide and ultimately the family member of the student and truly becomes guardian teacher.

Every month in second week, academic committee arranges a meeting of class-teachers to discuss the student’s feedback recorded in the meetings of class teachers with students. Principal takes necessary action on the shortcomings/lacunae and difficulties faced by students. The parents of irregular students and weak students are contacted. This helps to reduce the risk of failure of students and the number of drop- out students.

Professional counseling, mentoring and academic advice is provided to students by centrally developed mechanism “Career and Counseling Cell” of the college. Programmes on soft skill development, career opportunities in various fields, academic visits, workshops are organized by the cell.

The academic, personal and psycho-social support is also provided to the students as follows :

The teachers in concerned department take care to guide such students to achieve the best results in University examinations. The teachers advise the advanced learners to consult specific reference books from the library and specific sites through internet and help them to prepare notes for the exams. The teachers also encourage them to solve previous university examinations’ papers in prescribed time limit. The teachers are available 24 x 7 to such brilliant students on mobiles.

The college keeps the records or data of each student enrolled in college through class-teachers scheme. The class teachers’ diaries include all the information of the students under his/her guardianship. The guardian teachers collect the data and information such as family background, score in previous examination, economical conditions, psychological needs and correlate them with attendance in class, marks obtained in unit tests, results of university examinations, home assignment submission, participation in group discussion, seminar delivered by him/her, participation in other collegiate and inter collegiate competitions, participation in co-curricular and extracurricular activities, representation of college in games and sports, etc. All this exhaustive record is maintained by the guardian teacher who occasionally visits their homes as well and talks with their parents. This information helps the college to monitor the performance of students. Thus all the students including the students at the risk of drop out are identified and counseled to bring them back in normal mode through this scheme.

The college separately analyzes the data of examinations to identify the poor scorers and failed students. This data is utilized to help them by solving their difficulties to improve the performance of the students who are at the risk of drop out. For such student’s college teachers make extra efforts like personal coaching, through explanation to the topic and providing notes to them so as to make them to secure better in the examinations. The teachers are in constant touch with the students throughout the academic sessions. Even financial help is provided to such students to bring them back in normal stream.

College runs the Remedial Coaching-Classes for the students from disadvantaged sections of society, slow learners, economically weaker sections and physically challenged students. In the remedial classes the difficulties of the students are considered and solutions are provided.

2.5.2 Reforms initiated on Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) system at the institutional level (250 words)

To ensure effective implementation of the evaluation reforms of the university, college discusses on the new syllabus, scheme of marks, activities to be held for the internal assessments, guest lectures ,seminars and methods to be adopted for teaching the compete syllabus within prescribed time, in staff council meeting. The system is also communicated to students.

So as to cope up with new system of evaluation, college modifies its strategies related to internal and external evaluation of the students. College cares to display the model papers as per the university pattern, purchase the books as per requirement of the curriculum, teachers take practice of solving papers by the students etc. The examination departments look after effective implementation of the exam-pattern while adopting the reforms in college unit tests/pre semester examinations.

The college has on its own initiated following evaluation reforms.

- i. Additional class tests are held for every subject.
- ii. One unit test is held per semester.
- iii. Pre-semester examination before university examination is held in every semester.
- iv. Home assignments are given in addition to those prescribed by university.

For effective implementation of these evaluation reforms the college takes following steps.

- i. The schedule of the college unit tests / pre-semester examinations is printed in the college prospectus.
- ii. At the beginning of the session every teacher informs the students about the college evaluation process.
- iii. The college displays all the information related to the internal evaluation including results on the notice board.
- iv. Teachers provide question bank with sample question papers and model answers on the subject taught by them.
- v. The entire process is closely monitored by the Academic Committee, Staff Council and the Principal.

2.5.3 Academic calendar prepared and adhered for conduct of Examinations and other related matters.

The whole teaching, learning and evaluation process is monitored by an academic committee comprising of the Principal, Academic in charge, and Assistant in charge, Class teacher-in-charge and all the concerned class teachers. The academic committee undertakes following tasks every year.

i. Academic calendar

College decides the academic calendar for the next academic session at the end of the previous session in the last staff council meeting of the session (generally held on the last working day of the session). The academic calendar is fully discussed and finalized and then incorporated in the prospectus for the next academic session.

The academic calendar includes the details of schedule for submission of home assignments, conduct of unit tests / class tests / pre-semester terminal examinations, monthly teaching plan and monthly portion to be covered alongwith scheduled of various meetings, Guest Lectures and Extension Activity, etc. .

ii. Teaching plan

The teaching plan is finalized in the first staff council meeting. In accordance with the guidelines of the teaching plan, teachers prepare plans in the prescribed format and record in their daily diary.

The college prepares evaluation blueprint in advance which includes plan of unit tests, class tests, pre-semester and terminal examinations. Exam In-charge finalizes the dates for college examinations as per the academic calendar. Unit tests and class tests are arranged in the last weeks of September and February. Pre-semester and terminal examinations are arranged in the second weeks of October, March and first week of April. Notices related to the examinations, such as time table, seating arrangement, etc. are displayed on the notice board in advance, i.e., atleast ten days prior to the commencement of the examination.

6.1 Institutional vision and leadership.

6.1.1: **Mention two practices of decentralization and participative management during the last year.**

➤ **Decentralization**

Following two practices of Decentralization have been adopted in the Institution.

1. **Sanction of Leave:** Leave sanction powers have been delegated to the one of the Senior faculty members holding the designation of Professor by the Principal excluding medical leaves. The application of leave is routed through Head of the Department.
2. **Allocation of Teaching work:** Teaching work is allotted at Departmental level exclusively. The Head of the Department conducts meeting with staff of the department and the teaching work is shared amongst the teachers in the light of existing rules of Government and the University.

➤ **Participative management:**

Feedback of various stake holders is sought every year through personnel meeting with Principal and Faculty through the complaint box. Suggestion regarding upgradation or creation of infrastructure facilities and for addition of any academic programme is considered and implemented if the management feels it necessary to implement.

➤ **Case study**

Allocation of workload:

1. Workload prescribed as per university ordinance is calculated based on the students admissions of the Department for Post Graduate & Undergraduate courses i.e. M.Sc. & B.Sc. by the Head of the Department.
2. On calculation of the workload, the Head of the Department distribute the teaching work amongst the teachers with due consideration of topic of interests and specialization of the concern teachers.
3. Finally the copy of time table is submitted to the Principal for information.

Participative Management:

1. Representation is received form staff members for creation of four wheeler parking place.
2. The same was forwarded to management by the Principal.
3. It was considered by the management and the parking place has been created.

6.2.1: Quality improvement strategies adopted by the institution for each of the following.

1. Curriculum Development

The institution ensures effective curriculum delivery through a well-planned and documented process. Institution follows curriculum designed by Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati.

Institution prepares planned academic calendar for each academic year before its commencement and implemented from the start of academic year. Month wise activities for students are performed in a regular manner. Also various departments play a vital role for conducting co-curricular and extracurricular activities. For proper implementation of curricular activities, various committees comprising teachers are formed for smooth delivery of such activities. Academic in-charge verifies the academic diaries of each teacher at regular intervals in which proposed teaching plan and actual teaching plan is mentioned.

2. Teaching & Learning.

The institute monitors the quality of teaching and learning through, *Academic diary*

Record is verified through the academic diaries. The academic diary provided to each teacher consists of records of teaching plan and actual teaching, attendance of students, marks secured by students in their college examination as well as in university examinations. On the basis of these records the teacher provides the information to class teachers.

The class teacher arranges a meeting with the batch of students allotted to him / her. In this meeting, he / she collects information on:

Extent of course completed, Difficulties faced by students in understanding the subject, Availability of Library books, Internet facility, Difficulties in practical classes, Infrastructure facilities. The outcome of class teacher scheme is cross checked at the end of session.

The Principal discusses the performance of students in university and college examinations and parameters for internal assessment in staff meetings and the course position is also assessed periodically. He collects feedback from student representatives in student meetings.

College conducts a confidential evaluation of teachers by students at the end of session. In this process of evaluation of teacher by student college provides a printed questionnaire (16 multiple choice questions) to students and students fill up their answers depending on their findings about the particular teacher.

The questionnaire records the merits and demerits of the teacher's teaching quality. This assessment, after valuation, is shown to concerning teacher and suggestions are given for improvement. (The best teachers are encouraged and erring teachers are warned, if needed.)

3. Examination & Evaluation

The college has on its own initiated following evaluation reforms.

1. Additional class tests are held for every subject.
2. One unit test is held per semester.
3. Pre-semester examination before university examination is held in every semester.
4. Home assignments are given in addition to those prescribed by the university.

For effective implementation of these evaluation reforms the college takes following steps.

1. The schedule of the college unit tests / pre-semester examinations is printed in the college prospectus.

2. At the beginning of the session, every teacher informs the students about the college evaluation process.
3. The college displays all the information related to the internal evaluation including results on the notice board.
4. Teachers provide question bank with sample question papers and model answers on the subject taught by them.
5. The entire process is closely monitored by the Academic Committee, Staff Council and the Principal.

4. Research and Development

To improve quality of research and to develop innovative ecosystem, our institution has established 'Research Cell' under which the different strategies are planned. Research cell acts as agency for the promotion of research development in the college. The principal of the college acts as chairman and one of the senior faculty members as a co-ordinator. Senior researchers of the college are selected as the members of this cell. Different activities are planned by the research cell so as to motivate the faculty and students for performing research. The different schemes for funding are discussed with faculty members through research cell.

Three departments of our institutes have been recognized as the Research Centres by the Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati. These departments have been provided high tech equipment's so as to cope up other new advances in the concerned subjects. To develop innovative ecosystem, workshops and seminars are organized on Intellectual property rights and other related themes. Proposal of Incubation Centre is submitted to NITI Ayog so as to promote and motivate our budding scientists. Faculties are motivated for publication in reputed journals and guidelines are given so as to avoid the chances of piracy.

5. Library, ICT and Physical Infrastructure/ Instrumentation

The college ensures optimal allocation and utilization for maintenance of infrastructure and upkeep of the facilities. The College every year makes budgetary provisions for the enhancement and augmentation of the college infrastructure including laboratory equipment's and approval to these allocations is granted by the Governing Body. Maintenance and upkeep of the infrastructure facilities and equipments is done under the committee chaired by the Principal along with Professor In-charge and Office Superintendent. The suggestion or complaint arising in the class teacher meeting coming directly from students are given priority in upkeeping the infrastructure facilities. The clean drinking facilities with improved RO Plant has been installed and made functional. Taking in consideration the continuous Increase in the number of new time relevant and need based courses and the consequent growth in the number of students, the college (Management) has undertaken the ambitious project of construction of 3rd Floor for adding newly 14 Classrooms with independent Staff Room, Restrooms for Ladies and Gents. The estimated expenditure is over 1.25Cr.

We have library Advisory Committee is in place for planning and implementation of quality initiatives. The librarian, acting as a Co-ordinator, gathers the requirements of books from students, teachers and other Library users. The list of books is approved by the Principal and the purchases are made through the transparent purchasing mechanism practised by the college. The library issues smart identity card to all students. The books are issued by electronic scanning.

The college has purchased 15 computers with latest configuration and installed fiber optic connectivity with all departments to enhance the efficiency of internet services to students and staff. This facilitated to faculty prepare computer aided teaching/ learning materials through computer and internet provided to the individual departments.

2. Objectives of the Practice

The objectives of New Girl Students Orientation are:

- To facilitate self-growth, self-worth and actualization of potential of the students through myriad ways of empowerment and competence building.
- To introduce girl students to college services which will support their educational and personal goals (ex. library, information technology and academics).
- To familiarize students with the campus environment and physical facilities.
- To create an atmosphere that minimizes anxiety, promotes positive attitudes, and stimulates an excitement for learning.
- To provide a welcoming atmosphere for the girls student to meet faculty, staff especially ladies staff, ,as well as other new students.
- To provide the new girl students comprehensive information about the academic and student service resources and programs like NSS, NCC, Student Council, Remedial Coaching, Competitive exam Coaching, etc.

3. The Context

Girl's orientation is like sowing the seed to raise the green plant of a charming full grown family which bears fruits. The GSO course serves as the orientation course provided for first semester college girl students to assist them in the acquisition of fundamental skills essential for academic and overall success. This course is offered primarily through the Equal Opportunity Centre established for the betterment of the girl student of the college. This course serves as the anchor course among the girls. The college endeavours to do its best to reach out to each student and nurture her potential. The attempt is to draw out individual students to unfurl their wings and explore their areas of interest, not only in academics but in extra-curricular activities as well. 4. The Practice

The GSO for first year girls students of BBA, BCA and B.Sc. was held from 10th July 2017 to 15th July 2017. As the girls are on their first step of the chosen career and a very different mode of their life, it is very important to orient them in the right direction. Keeping this in view, the Equal Opportunity Centre organized one week GSO which was designed to facilitate academic, cultural, social, physical awareness amongst the girls.

1 : Healthy Womanhood

With the intention to impart knowledge on “**Healthy Womanhood**”, the first lecture was on 10/07/17. It was delivered by Dr. S.R.Katke, Head, Department of Zoology. She boldly and clearly discussed many facts with the girls which were very important to understand. It was noticed that most of the girls were unaware of their physiology and were very happy with the initiative.

2 : Importance of Health and Fitness

At a very young age girls have low hemoglobin levels, low calcium levels. Girls don't take proper diet, which gives rise to many health issues, which in turn causes mental and physical stress to them. They can't concentrate on their studies. Dr. Reena Laharia, Assistant Professor, Department of Zoology, explained the girls about the importance of maintaining good health and hygiene on 11/7/17.

3 : Real Happiness

There are lot of pressures on today's teens, regarding studies, co-curricular activities, expectations from family, teachers, friends, etc. The cases of depression are increasing day by day. On 12/7/17, Mrs. Honrao, Head, Department of Commerce and Management Department explained how we can find Real Happiness in very small things, small moments which are generally neglected by us.

4 : Emotional Intelligence

As the students step in the outside world, it is important that they should develop their Emotional Intelligence. On 12/7/17, Mrs. M.A. Bhuptani, Assistant Professor, Department of Commerce and Management, guided the students to control over anger, take criticism as a challenge and increase acceptance power.

5 : Legal Awareness

Our government has framed many laws for the safety and security of women. But girls are not aware of these laws. So Mrs. Shaila Nibjiya, Department of Commerce and Management, on 13/7/17, guided the girls about these legal provisions and safety rules for girls. She explained in detail article 14 to the girls.

6 : Effect of Mobiles & Computers on Human

As there are advancements in technology and new development in Mobiles and Computers, the current generation is totally dependent on it. They should know merits and demerits of these.

On 14/7/17, Dr. Varsha Tondre, Head, Department of Computer Science, guided girls about the ill effects of mobiles and computer on human body especially, a women body. She explained hoe a change in DNA can take place by continuous exposure to the mobile waves.

7 : Effect of Mobiles & Computers on Environment

We are facing a major issue of global warming and our environment is under a big threat. Excessive use of technology adds to it. Dr. Ujjwala Junghare, Department of Computer Science, explained the effects of development in technology on environment on 14/7/17. She also guided the student as to how they can contribute for saving the environment and what precautions are to be taken to save our mother nature.

Yoga Sessions

Yoga in daily life develops the areas of physical, mental social and spiritual health. When the body is physically healthy, the mind is clear focused and stress is under control.

Keeping this in view, Yoga sessions were provided to girls daily for 20 minutes. Mrs. Gadwe, Ex-Faculty, Department of Statistics, took the efforts to teach yogasans to the girls daily. Ms. Sharayu Dhakite, Department of Biotechnology, gave the practicals.

5. Evidence of Success

On 15th July 2017, a valedictory function was organized to get the feedback from girls.

- Girls gave a very positive feedback of the workshop and requested for some more sessions to be conducted in future.
- Girls also informed in their feedback that through this orientation program they got introduced to all the incharges of various activities like NSS, NCC, EOC, Youth Festival, CCC, Women Grievance Cell, Career Counseling Cell, etc and therefore now can avail different facilities.
- In their feedback, girls also informed that knowing their own structure in the healthy womanhood class made them more confident about themselves.
- They were able to identify health risks related to ignorance of hygiene and minor problems
- They were able to understand legal provisions available for protecting them and their basic rights
- They became familiar with various legislations to demand their due share in society.
- Girls engaged in activities designed to improve their study and learning skills and to enhance their personal growth and development.
- Girls were able to identify personal time management systems that work for them.
- Girls were able to successfully identify stress management techniques.
- Girls were able to identify resources in the community that are available to promote and enhance their personal growth and development

Muktangan- Year 2017-18 **(Transforming Lives of Slum Children)**

Title of the Practice: Muktangan is an informal school for the children in slum area.

Goal: To help the children of nearby slum to develop awareness for education, opportunities of creativity, sense of social behavior, good food and cleanliness habits along with the overall development of their personality and living standards.

The Context:

The slum area adjacent to the college has a population of about 500. The families living in this area are mostly workers and all of them are migrated from different areas of the state and adjacent state. Their economic level is 'hand to mouth' and literacy level very miserable. They do not understand the importance of education. Once they are out of the house, their children are inculcating bad habits. Poverty forced many parents to send their children for work and earn livelihood. The management of the college wanted to execute their social responsibility to educate the children from this slum area.

The Practice:

Since 2001, this activity has been going on successfully till date. In it as a social responsibility, Muktangan executes their programmes with support from the management, college principal, teachers and students of the college.

Children under the project are being trained on vital aspects of personality development like behavior and etiquette, hygiene, cleanliness, health, good values and habits, social concerns. They are also being given training on art, craft, dance and drama through workshops and cultural programmes.

Functioning of Muktangan:

1. This year the volunteers enrolled in the "Earn while you learn Scheme" were selected under the guidance of in-charge of Muktangan. Initially they visit the slum area and enroll the children for Muktangan.
2. Every Sunday, the enrolled children from the slum area are called at 8.00 am within the college campus for the informal school.
3. They are taught subjects like English, Maths and Science.
4. Selected volunteers work as their teachers.
5. Classes are taken from 8.00 am to 10.30 am only on Sundays.

6. To enhance their personality and overall development, the children are guided through different activities like games, various competitions etc. The students are made aware about health and hygiene, cleanliness, environment etc.
7. Every student has given books / pens by the institution.

Special Focus & Objectives:

1. To Create awareness about the education among the parents from the socio-economically weaker section of the society.
2. To educate the children about good habits, health, hygiene and cleanliness.
3. To provide the platform for creativity and responsibility.

Muktangan Library:

In order to inculcate the habit of reading among these students, a separate library was there. Muktangan library is the most important activity as it reflects the interest of students towards reading. The library has approximately 200 to 300 books. The student in-charge is nominated for the distribution of books to the children.

Gathering and farewell function:

At the end of the session social gathering and farewell function is organized. The students of Muktangan take part in various cultural activities like dance, singing song, drama etc.

Resources:

The management always provides necessary funds for this noble cause and in addition to this.

1. Books, Pens and other contingency, class rooms, chalk, duster etc and teaching materials are provided by the college.
2. Every Sunday energetic eatables are given to the Muktangan students.
3. Faculties associated with Muktangan from many years sponsored best student prizes for the winners along with refreshment last year also. Teachers of the Muktangan were also honoured.

Problems Faced:

During the initial phase of Muktangan various observations were made by the teachers and volunteers.

- Lack of awareness for education was observed among slum dwellers.
- Addiction to alcohol/liquor prohibited the parents from future planning of their children.
- Misbehavior of liquor consumers was the major hindrance for the volunteer during initial survey.
- Poverty forced the parents to send their children for earning wages instead of attending school.

Benefits of Muktangan:

A) Children of slum area:

- It helped them to improve their writing and grammar.
- It made them aware regarding cleanliness, health and hygiene.

- It helped them to remove the fear of English, Science and Maths, and increased their interest in this subjects.

- It increased the confidence and developed their personality through various competitions.

B) Volunteers of Earn-While-You-Learn-Scheme:

8. Future Plans of action for next academic year (500 words)


Proposed Plan for the year 2018-2019
