Bonsai Making Workshop

Bonsai is an art form that stems from ancient Asian culture, originating in China and developed by the Japanese. In the 13th century, the Japanese collected and potted wild trees that had been dwarfed by nature. These naturally formed miniatures were some of the first bonsai. A bonsai is literally a “tree in a pot,” which further imitates, in miniature, the appearance of an old tree in nature. Old specimens in nature, unlike juvenile trees, have compact rounded tops, and horizontal or drooping branches, which make them, appear aged and graceful. There are three sizes of bonsai, ranging from less than 5 inches to about 30 inches in height. Not all plants are equally effective as bonsai. To produce a realistic illusion of a mature tree, all parts of the ideal bonsai such as trunk, branches, twigs, leaves, flowers, fruits, buds, roots should be in perfect proportion with the size of the tree. Plants used for bonsai should have small leaves or leaves that become small under bonsai culture. Leaves will become miniature naturally the longer a tree grows in a shallow container, but one must still begin with a relatively small-leaved type. Plants chosen for bonsai should have attractive bark, and the trunk must give the illusion of maturity. The trunk should have girth, but must remain in proportion to the entire tree and should taper gradually toward the top of the tree. An ideal trunk has good buttress rootage at the base, and graceful movement as it rises to the apex. Bonsai are not genetically dwarfed plants; in fact, any tree species can be used to grow one

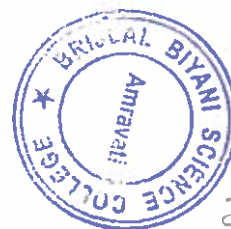
Objective:

- Re-potting- Time to get your hands dirty! Re-potting techniques are covered including root pruning, and selecting a bonsai pot for your bonsai tree.

Outcome:

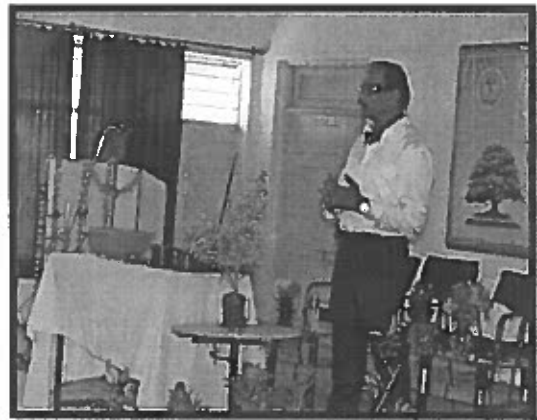

Introduction:

Bonsai is an art form that stems from ancient Asian culture, originating in China and developed by the Japanese. In the 13th century, the Japanese collected and potted wild trees that had been dwarfed by nature. These naturally formed miniatures were some of the first bonsai. A bonsai is literally a "tree in a pot," which further imitates, in miniature, the appearance of an old tree in nature. Old specimens in nature, unlike juvenile trees, have compact rounded tops, and horizontal or drooping branches, which make them, appear aged and graceful. There are three sizes of bonsai, ranging from less than 5 inches to about 30 inches in height. Not all plants are equally effective as bonsai. To produce a realistic illusion of a mature tree, all parts of the ideal bonsai such as trunk, branches, twigs, leaves, flowers, fruits, buds, roots should be in perfect proportion with the size of the tree. Plants used for bonsai should have small leaves or leaves that become small under bonsai culture. Leaves will become miniature naturally the longer a tree grows in a shallow container, but one must still begin with a relatively small-leafed type. Plants chosen for bonsai should have attractive bark, and the trunk must give the illusion of maturity. The trunk should have girth, but must remain in proportion to the entire tree and should taper gradually toward the top of the tree. An ideal trunk has good buttress rootage at the base, and graceful movement as it rises to the apex. Bonsai are not genetically dwarfed plants; in fact, any tree species can be used to grow one

Objective:

- The objectives of this exercise are to learn about bonsai
- To start training a plant as a bonsai.
- The objective is to learn the art of pruning and reinforce it by pruning the plant as a bonsai
- The ultimate goal of growing a Bonsai is to create a miniaturized but realistic representation of nature in the form of a tree.

Methodology:

The Department of Botany, Brijlal Biyani Science College, Amravati, organized one-day workshop and hands-on training on Bonsai making in collaboration with Amravati Garden Club, Amravati on September 19, 2019. Dr.D.T.Deshmukh, head Department of Statistics, presided over the function. Dr. Dinesh Khedkar, president, Garden Club, Amravati was the Chief Guest and inaugurated the function. The workshop was facilitated by the experienced bonsai artist Dr.Kishor Bobade to
