

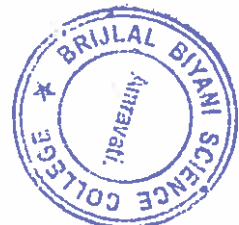
## MINI BAZAR


