### **TRAINING & PLACEMENT CELL**

One of the unique features of college is that it has a training & placement cell for UG and PG students. Variety of activities are arranged under the placement cell like conducting aptitude tests, seminars, group discussions, guest lecturers by industrial experts, soft skill workshops and importantly placement drives. The prime objective of the training & placement cell is to provide employment opportunities to the students. Training & placement cell also provides internship to students so as to introduce them with industrial environment and to develop the skill set they need to have in order to be employable. Interested students are requested to contact prof-incharge, training & placement cell for guidance time to time.

In this academic year limited placement related activities were conducted in the college. Placement related activities were conducted to make student realize the industrial environment and the skillset they need to have in order to be employable. The activities performed in academic year 2020-21 are as follows:

#### **(1) ONLINE PLACEMENT DRIVE BY ICICI BANK:**

The placement cell of Brijlal Biyani Science College, Amravati has organized an online placement drive by ICICI Bank on the 5th of May 2021. Total 56 students from our college and 03 students from other colleges have attended the placement drive. Total 11 students qualified for the interview and appeared for Online Personal interviews. Lastly, 05 students got successfully placed in ICICI Bank as Bank Valuer.

Students were placed in ICICI Bank from Brijlal Biyani Science College with the package of 2,52,000/- per annum.

#### **(2) INTERNSHIP CUM PLACEMENT DRIVE BY DRYOMIX.**

The placement cell of Brijlal Biyani Science College, Amravati has organized an internship cum placement drive by DRYOMIX Pvt. Ltd on 21st of June 2021. DRYOMIX is a construction procurement and service platform providing company. Students were provided with notice and a link for registration so as to appear for a drive. Total 17 students from BBA III Year of our college have applied for the internship cum placement drive. Results of placements and internship selections are yet to be published.

Total 29 students from our college have applied for the internship cum placement drive. He explained the resources available for students in the online service industry. He promised to provide internships to our students. We received a good response from students.
